Vegetative and Household Debris Pickup Guidelines

Effective Date: August 1, 2014

1. Vegetative debris and household debris will be picked up weekly. Residents must contact City Hall and obtain a work order in order to schedule the pickup.
2. Building debris, such as scrap lumber, plaster, roofing, concrete, brickbats, and other such matter resulting from the construction, repair or remodeling of any building or appurtenances on private property, dirt, stumps and tree trunks, will not be removed by the sanitation department, but the owner or contractor must cause this waste to be privately moved.
3. Residents must place all vegetative debris by the roadway or street's edge away from obstruction such as overhead electrical, telephone or cable television lines. All vegetative debris must be from existing yards.
4. All grass cuttings, pine straw and leaves shall be securely tied in plastic bags. These plastic bags must be of such quality and thickness as to contain all contents when they are picked up by hand or by mechanical devices.
5. This service is not provided for contract work such as tree surgeons, tree trimmers, pulp wood harvesters, plumbers, building contractors or roofing contractors. Neither is it for rubbish accumulations from private construction or tearing down existing structures.
6. The brush truck will be utilized for curbside pickup of vegetative debris and household debris contents only. These wastes must be loaded easily from a public street. The Street and Sanitation Department reserves the right to deny any load, or part of a load, based on the character of the waste or any other violation of the intent of this ordinance or of the compliance requirements of the landfill.
7. No refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers or similar appliances containing Freon will be picked up by city crews or accepted at the landfill. It is the responsibility of the owner to have such items removed and disposed by dealer or license specialist.
8. Yellow warning slips will be given to residents for any debris placed for pickup that does not comply with the above criteria.
