Mayor Davis presented the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-9

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to authorize residents of the City to use City owned folding tables, chairs, outdoor tents, coolers and flatware for a period of seventy-two (72) hours upon application therefor to the City Clerk or her designee on the required form and the posting of a security deposit of One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Graysville, Alabama, at a special meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

1. That the City Council does by adoption of this resolution, authorize residents of the City to use City owned folding tables, chairs, outdoor tents, coolers and flatware for a period of seventy-two

(72) hours upon application therefor to the City Clerk on the required form and payment of a security deposit in the amount of One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars. Said security deposit shall be refunded if the used items are returned to the City in a sanitary and undamaged condition as shall be determined by the City Clerk or her designee in her sole discretion.

2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council or as otherwise becoming law.
